
As a Church serving the Amherstburg region, we require our voluntary workers to have periodic Police Clearance checks appropriate for those working with vulnerable people (e.g., children and the elderly). This is simply standard practice for those involved in such activities on behalf of the Presbyterian Church in Canada. We then reimburse our volunteers for the police clearance fees, so as not to burden those who wish to "give back" to their local community.

If such clearance fees could be waived, that would lessen the financial burden of our Church in these challenging times – and would be much appreciated.

This issue was brought up and discussed at a recent community roundtable, hosted by Town of Amherstburg Councillor Patricia Simone. It impacts many not-for-profit organizations.
